

What's New in LSchart 16 (Medchart)

LSchart 16 is a major update to Medchart. The program has been extensively redesigned to be faster and more reliable. Some older and confusing parts have been removed and the features present have had to “earn” their places in the program.

Database Engine

- Uses MS Access 2010 for a cleaner and more efficient user interface
- Ribbon interface (rather than menus) to speed navigation
- More reliable operation
- Improved speed of searches
- New split forms for a better view of data
- More reliable handling of wireless networks (works best with Windows 7)

Billing

- New fee schedule
- New icd9 codes for GP incentive fees
- New MSP claim form
- Claim summary for each patient
- More error checks before claims sent
- Revised and streamlined private invoices

Referrals

- Attach lab results or reports to referral notes

Rosters

- A major update

- More user friendly
- Search features to add patients by demographics, medications, diagnosis, fee items, other rosters, family history, past history, lab results

Chart Features

- Build in scanner interface- scan directly to program
- Improved handling of Excelleris lab results
- Diabetes, hypertension thyroid, renal, CV risk, warfarin flow sheets
- Simple creation of rosters (e.g. diabetes, patients on medications etc.)
- Medical word processor
- Special MOA or MD views to access commonly used features
- Track orders (e.g. booked x-rays etc.)
- Recalls improved

Other new features

- Print on common requisitions
- Store and catalog documents such as hospital requisitions, patient handouts etc.
- Quickly print notes such as off work notes
- New manual

Compatibility

- Can handle legacy document scans from older versions of Medchart (prior to version 14)
